```
grep [options] PATTERN [FILE...]
```

What GP needs to see is the basic difference, where there may be multiple options, tests, and actions listed for /file/, there might be multiple files with /grep/. That last argument needs to be whichever entity is going to accept multiples.

(I've not trimmed the rest of Bill's excellent discussion, just because GP needs to read it again! There's a message there... which says this may be a little complex, but it *\*is\** the best way to get that kind of functionality! Not seeing the reasoning in a cursory examination doesn't mean there is not a valid reason. It just means UNIX wasn't haphazardly designed without looking past the obvious.)

>>find -iname . "*IPv6*"
