>> *I have FC2 and am using K3b to burn CDs and DVDs on a NEC 2500a DVD
>> drive. CD burning works fine and is fast. DVD burning works , but the
>> speed is always 1x , the drive is an 8X drive and I have tried both 4x
>> and 8x media and the speed is always 1x. The DVD burning speeds in K3b
>> have no effect. I read something about the version of CD record that
>> comes with FC2 being a hacked version to support DVD , does it support
>> burning at speeds > 1x. Is anybody getting 4x or 8x speeds while burning
>> DVDs?*

>

> *I get 4x speeds regularly. And k3b in FC2 doesn't use cdrecord to burn
> DVDs, it uses growisofs, as you will discover if you will simply click the
> "debug" button on the burning dialog.*

>

> *I suspect the problem is either your DVD r/w drive or the DVDs you are
> using.*
