Which means that it has been downloaded onto your machine. You  
couldn't see it if it wasn't.

What you are having problems with is saving it to disk.

> *Konqueror works though.*

So use it. Mozilla is real quirky sometimes.

> *How can I make Mozilla not display but instead download this?*  
>  
> *I have MIME type application--exe, Extension \*.exe set to save*  
> *to disk in Moz preferences. There's something fishy about the*  
> *link that makes Moz confused.*

wget -O /path/name.extension URL

The -O option allows you to save the file under whatever path/  
name/extension you want.

Wget is better than Mozilla or Konquerer for a lot of HTTP  
operations.
