Running Debian etch, and since getting AT&T Uverse service, I cannot connect my T30 wirelessly to the "Gateway" – a combo modem, router – SSID 2wire341. I've tried w/ and w/o WEP, used different channels, auto channel – I keep getting "No DHCPOFFERS received" from the Gateway. I am pretty sure the set-up's OK on the T30 end, and don't know what else to fool with on the Gateway. A Windows machine and an iphone do wireless automagically.
