> *You might try the following*
>
> *cp /usr/bin/uagent /usr/bin/uagent_orig*
> *then go through uagent and put*
> *echo "line xxx" >> /tmp/logit*
> *throughout the code bumping xxx to a new number for each line, then*
>
> *service uagent stop*
> *cp /dev/null /tmp/logit*
> *service uagent start*
> *cp /tmp/logit /root*
> *service uagent stop*
> *cp /dev/null /tmp/logit*
> *shutsown -r now*
>
> *diff /root/logit /tmp/logit*
>
