Hi,

thanks, in fact the settings for erase are different. The problem is that I don't know which configuration file sets them differently.

Both the user account and the root account do not have particular settings (e.g., no `.termcap`) and both are just sourcing `/etc/bashrc` in their `.bashrc` file.

In `/etc/profile` and `/etc/bashrc` (never chaged) I do not see any setting that should have a difference if the user is root or something else.

I could set the right value for erase with `stty` but I was curious to know where in standard FC3 installation is a setting that might cause this behavior.
