256 ram
5gb hdd
i am trying to follow the instruction for installation

```
vmlinuz0 initrd=initrd0.img vesa i8042.noloop
```

and then i tried

basically i left the following in the boot area

```
vmlinuz0 initrd=initrd0.img root=cdlagel=fedora=8=live=i686 rootfstype=iso9660 ro quiet  
liveing rhgb vesa i8042.noloop
```

the first way i get an error

and the second way i get garbled up graphics.

what should i do after this point

creat symling /dev/root and then exit this shell to continue
the boot sequence.

```
